## CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS Grant Proposal 2023-2024 School Year

The Lumpkin County Education Foundation (LCEF) is a private, non-profit charitable organization dedicated to enriching our children's public school educational opportunities.

LCEF provides grants on an annual basis for broad-based enrichment projects, activities, or trips (referred to here as "projects").

For the 2023-2024 school year, the Foundation anticipates approximately **\$10,000.00** to disburse for grants. Notice of grant awards will be announced via email in mid-September.

Projects may be class-based, interdisciplinary, or departmental in scope.

A grant request may be for up to \$2,500.

## **Eligibility Criteria**

- ✓ Applicant is a licensed LCSS educator.
- ✓ Project is designed for broad groups of students: individual class, grade level team, entire grade level, or other cross section of students.
- Project expenses <u>may not include</u> employee salaries, routine school supplies or equipment, other normal expenses, scholarships, or athletic activities. (Examples of items excluded from grant purchases are laptops, iPads, or office supplies normally supplied for classroom instruction, furniture.)
- ✓ Project is designed to be started and completed within the current school year.
- ✓ An educator may submit only one application.
- ✓ Submissions accepted until September 5, 2023, 6pm.
